

Spanish Camp COVID-19 Update

We are open and excited to safely welcome you to Spanish Camp!

COVID19 Action Plan

1. Daily sanitation of the facilities and materials. Staff will be disinfecting before, after, and during the camp day.
2. Encouraged hygiene practices throughout the day. Staff will help children with everyday preventative actions and supervise routine hand washing and hand sanitation. Mask use for children and staff.
3. Encouraged social distancing. Along with verbal reminders, we will help promote social distancing by spreading out chairs, marking floor spots, and avoiding activities that involve close contact with others.
4. Implementation of consistent small groups to further reduce group sizes.
4. Limited shared supplies and equipment.
5. Modified space. Limit of 10 people in each indoor room. Increased outdoor time.
6. Implementation of a strict sickness policy. Staff and campers who are sick will be required to stay home. Staff and campers who have been exposed to sickness will be required to stay home.
7. Health and temperature screening upon entry. Staff will have in gloves and masks and maintain strict social distancing.

QUESTION 1: Is anyone in your family showing any signs of one or more of the following symptoms that are not related to a chronic condition: fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell?

QUESTION 2: To your knowledge, has a family member been in direct contact within the last 14 days with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID - 19 (clinically or test confirmed)? Direct contact is defined as being with the person infected for 15 minutes or more at less than 6 feet distance.

If you answer yes to either question, you will be asked to stay home and not participate in camp.

If you answer no to both questions, we will use a no-contact thermometer to check for a fever (100.4 degrees or higher).
